

TELEPHONE CALLS AND EMERGENCIES

We encourage you to make non-emergency telephone calls during our regular business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Our highly qualified nurses will be able to answer many of your medical questions. If you have a complex problem, the doctor will be consulted and your phone call returned as soon as possible.

For after-hours emergencies, there is always a physician on call, including over weekends and holidays. The CICC answering service number is 317-202-7267.

PRESCRIPTIONS AND REFILLS

To continue your medical care, please verify your prescriptions prior to your visit. If you need a new prescription, please call our office and we will phone in a prescription to your pharmacy. For your convenience, you may take advantage of the retail pharmacy at our East location. Please avoid prescription requests on the weekends. Prescriptions for narcotics can only be filled during normal business hours and cannot be called in.

LAB TESTS AND RESULTS

All lab tests will be reviewed personally by a health care professional. If a test or other procedure is performed at a facility other than our office, they will bill you or your insurance separately for those services.

INSURANCE

Insurance billing can be complex, and our staff is equipped to handle your concerns. At your initial visit a staff member will meet with you to discuss our billing policies and review your insurance coverage. Please notify our office if your carrier of coverage changes, and keep in mind that all co-payments are due at the time of your visit.

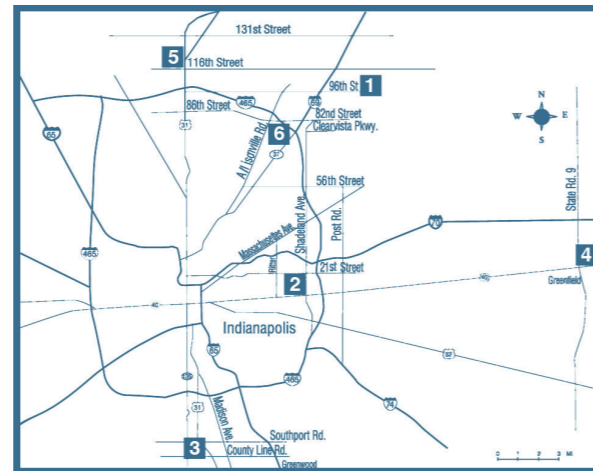
